Coal City continued to battle as they scored single tallies in the sixth and seventh innings to account for the final score.

Colwell lead the Comets with two hits. Schoonover would add a triple to the Comets' six hit attack.

Thomas Youskevtch and Gubelman had RBI singles for Coal City.
